




Q2 Do you work in an essential industry?





Q3 How would you describe your relationship to the children living in your house?





Q4 Do you have access to the technology needed to accommodate remote learning for your children (high speed internet, computer availability, etc.)?





Q5 What is the primary barrier to remote learning?















Q13 Household Income





Q14 Age




