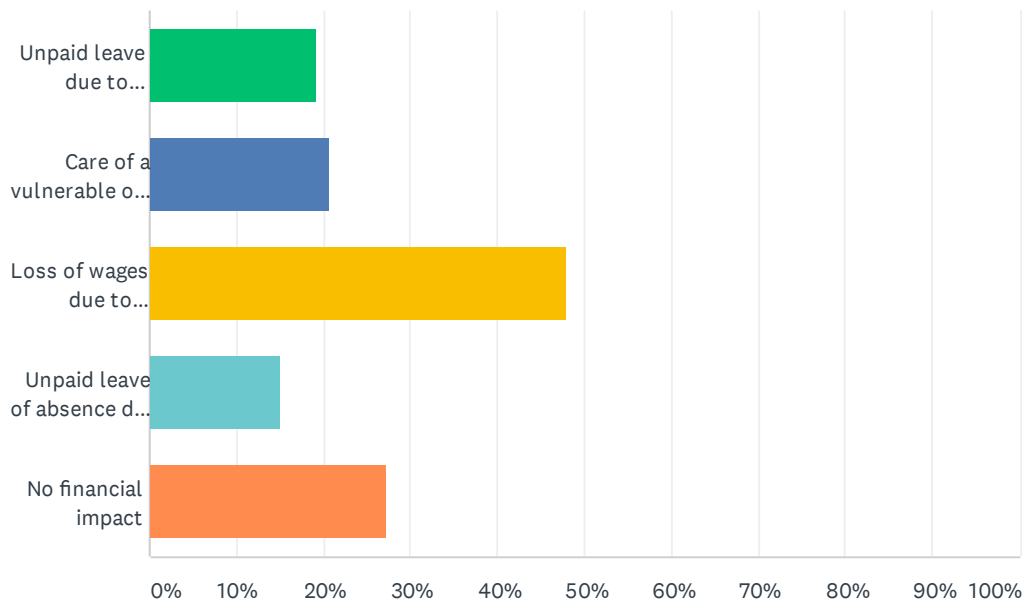

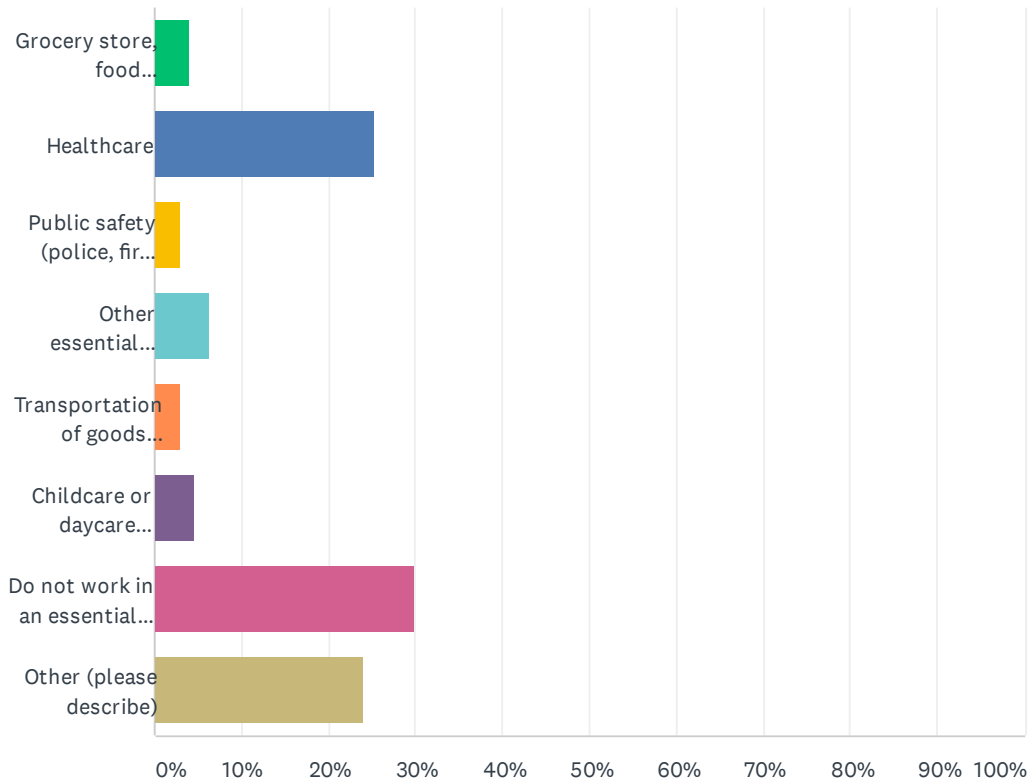

## Q2 Do you work in an essential industry?

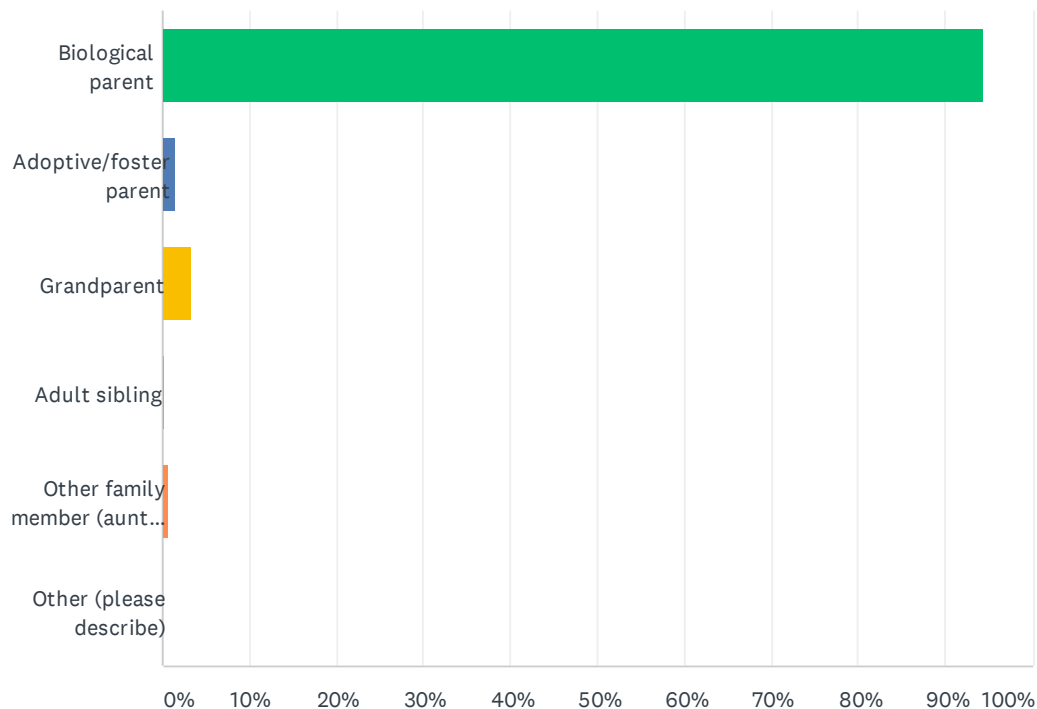

## Q3 How would you describe your relationship to the children living in your house?

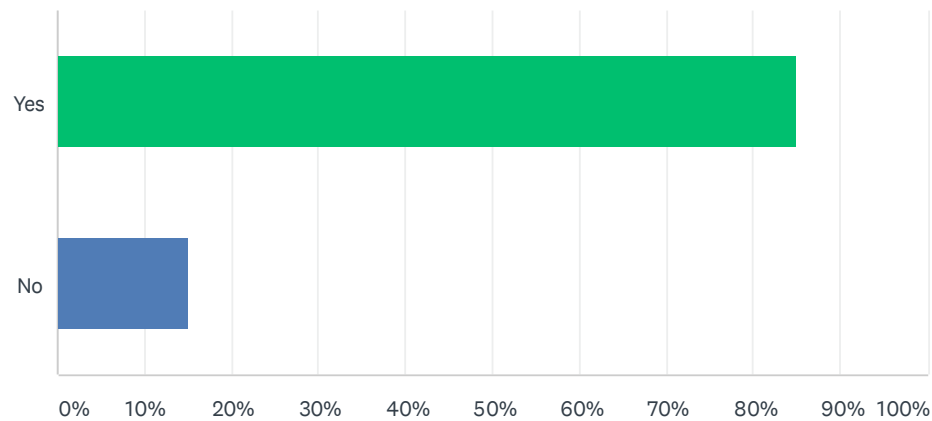

## Q4 Do you have access to the technology needed to accommodate remote learning for your children (high speed internet, computer availability, etc.)?

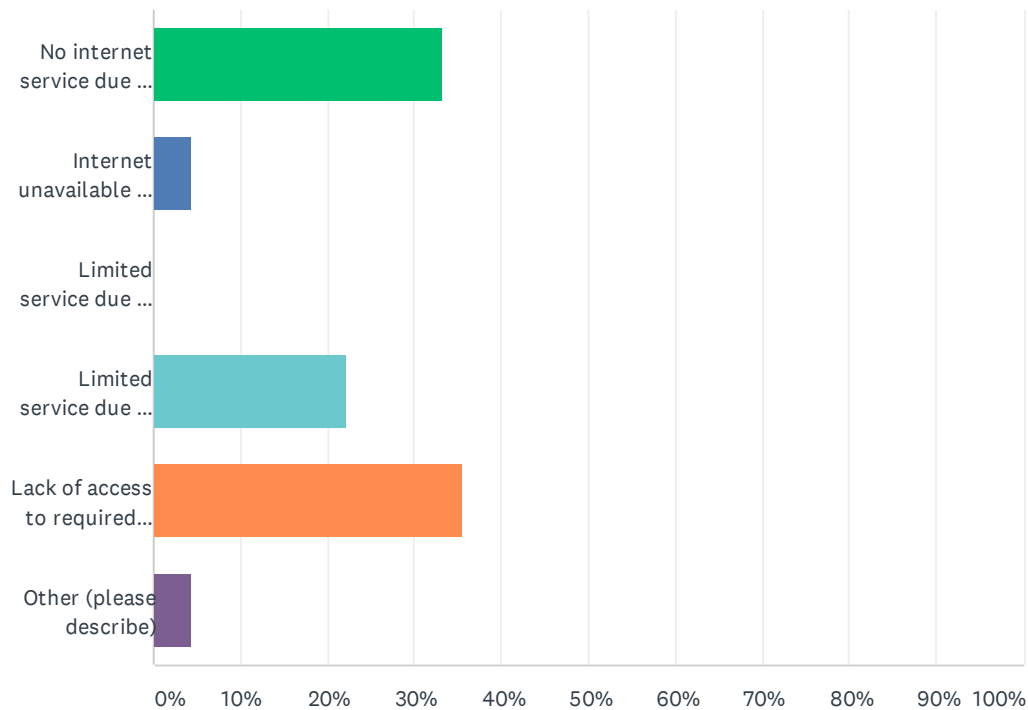

## Q5 What is the primary barrier to remote learning?

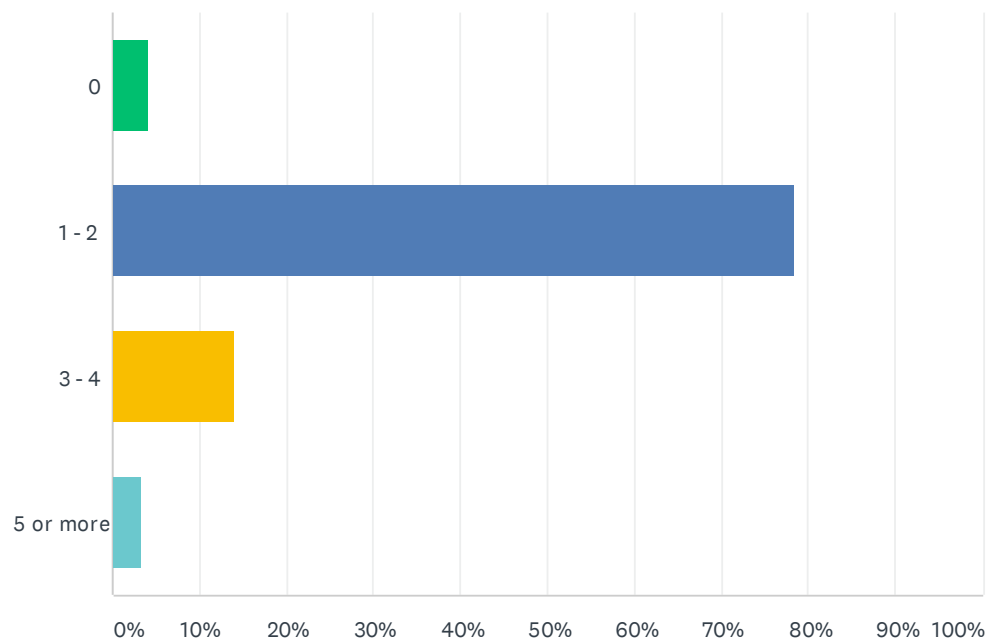

## Q6 How many devices (computers, tablets, etc.) in your home are available or readily accessible for remote learning?

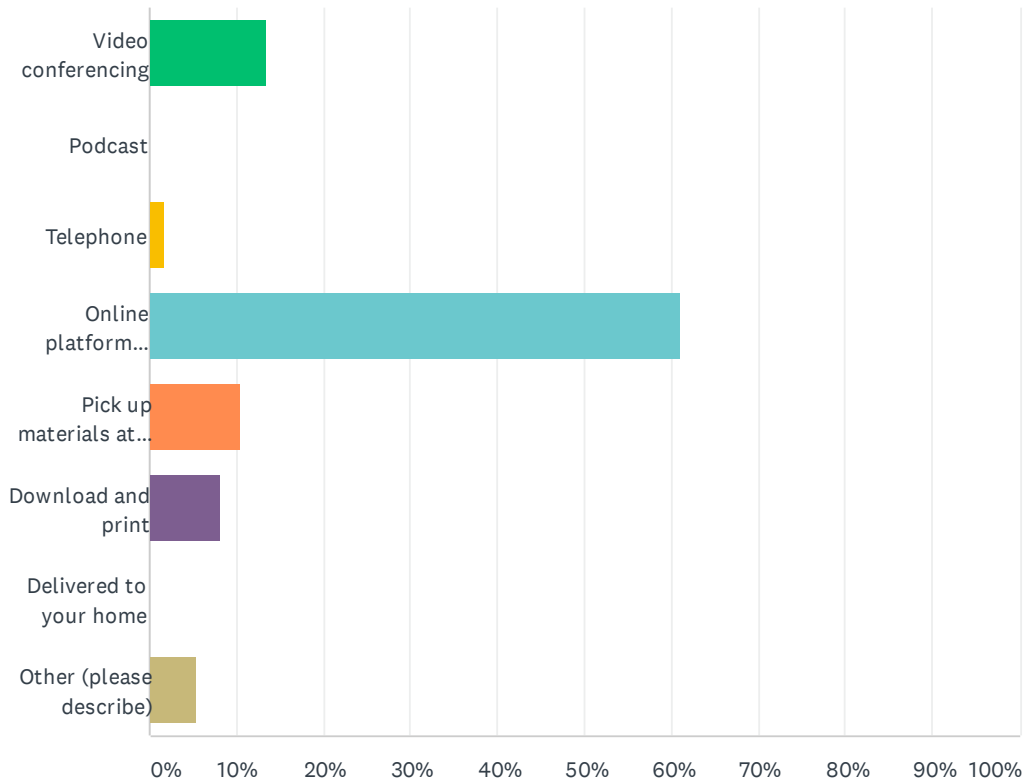

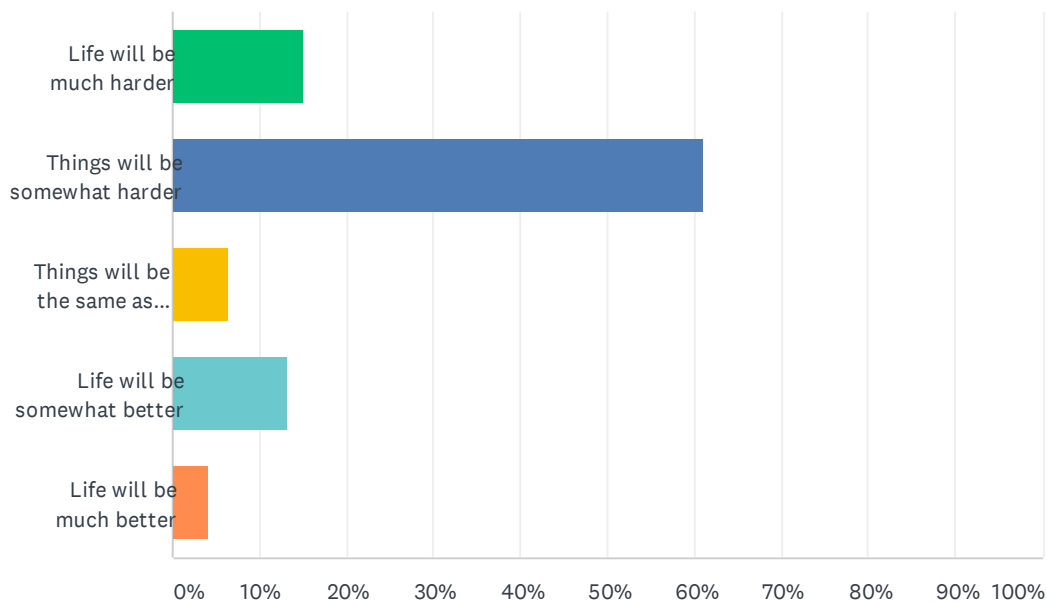

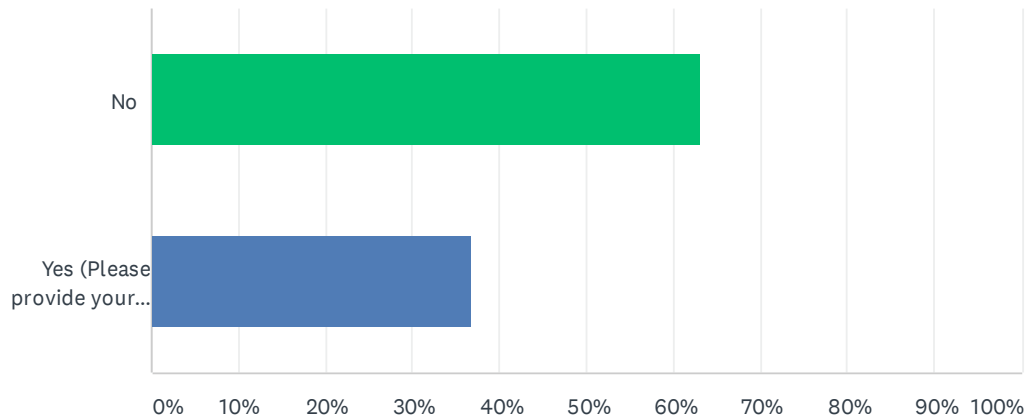

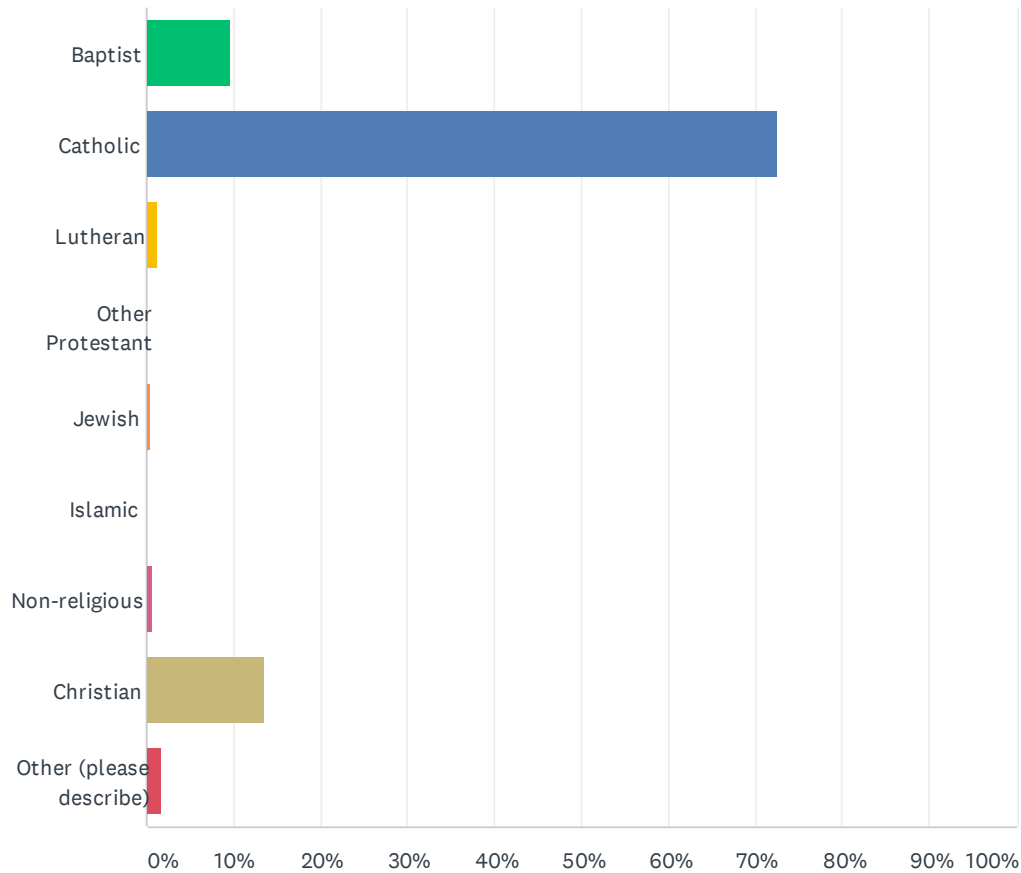

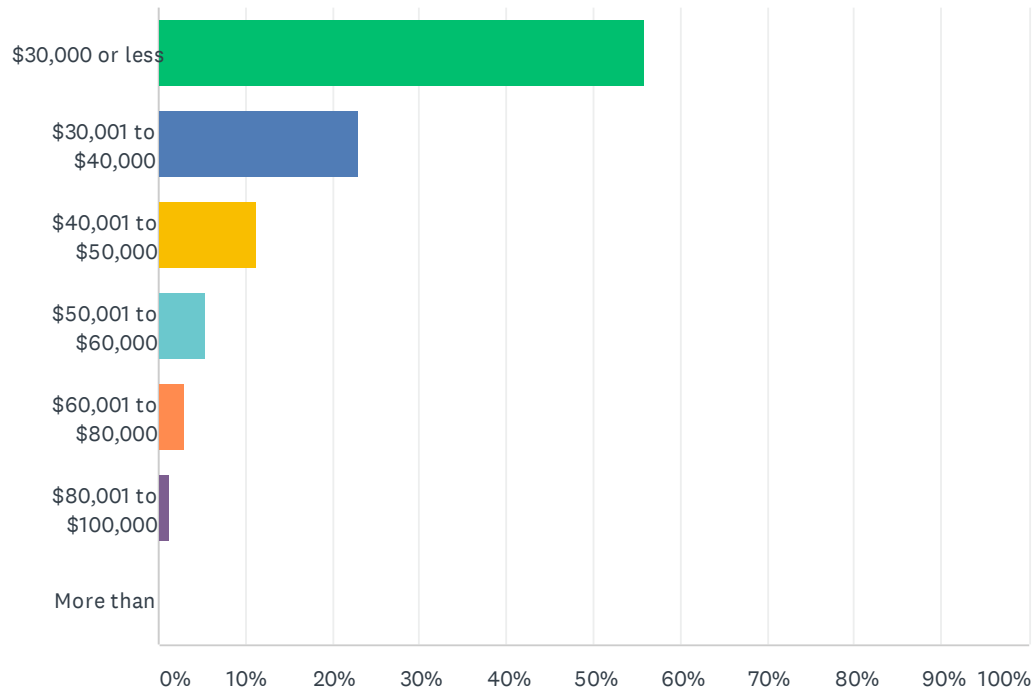

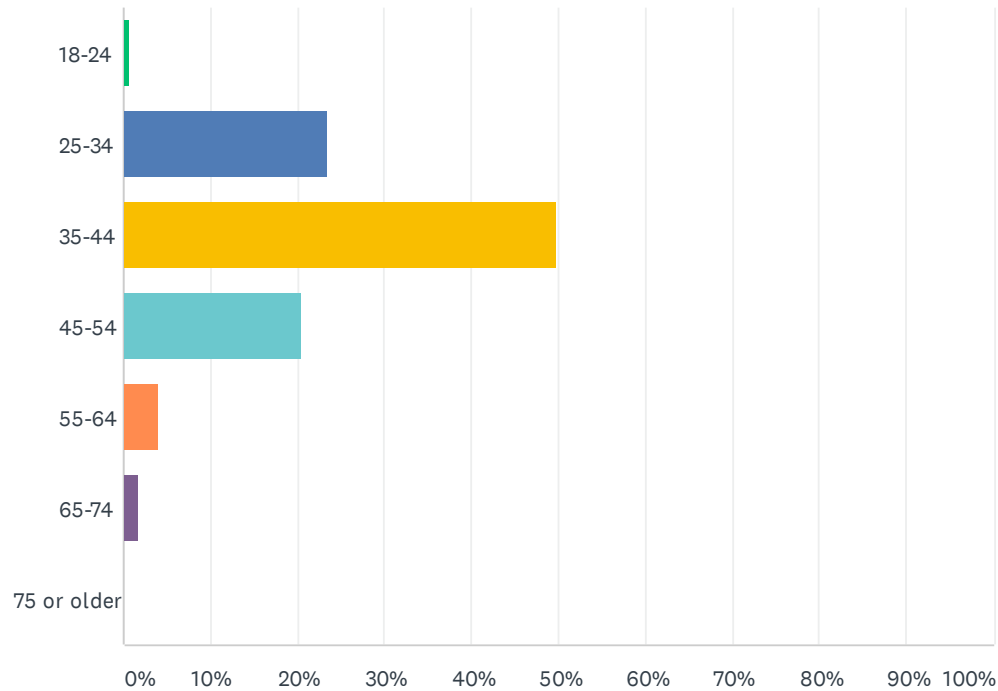

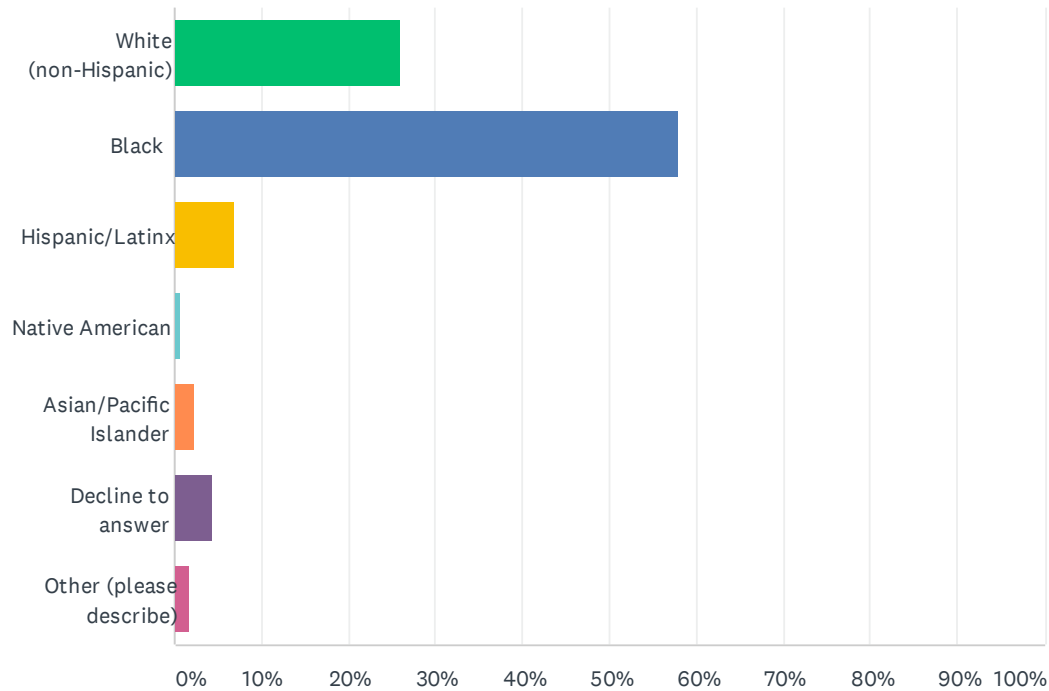

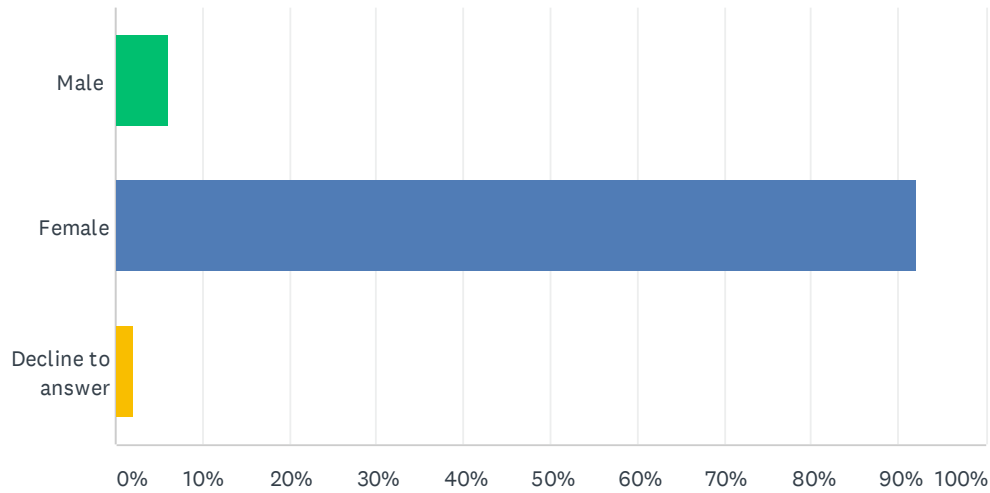
